### Ngā mea hauora


Our Public Health Nurse is Whaea Rebecca Sinclair (Tangata tiriti / Te Atiawa). She visits our kura regularly on a Monday morning at 9.10am. She is available to discuss hauora for tamariki, growth and development, skin and ear infections, sore throats and rheumatic fever, asthma, allergies, eczema, head lice, wetting and soiling, hearing, vision or dental concerns and immunisations.

Public Health Nurses work together with whānau and the kura to promote hauora of tamariki and rangatahi. They also offer the school based immunisation programme, including Boostrix (diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis) boosters in Year 7, and HPV (human papillomavirus) vaccine to year 8 students. They can also visit to offer catch up immunisations like the MMR which protects against measles, mumps and rubella.
