Ministry of education regulation requirement Schools must ensure students do not use or access a Phone while they are attending school, including during lunch time and breaks. This includes students who are on a school course or visit outside school grounds.

Schools must allow the students to use or access a phone when:

- A Phone is needed for health reasons (example; to monitor insulin Levels)
- A phone is needed to help student with a learning disability or learning support need (for example to assist with impaired communication)
- Or
  - A teachers requires a student to use phones for a specific educational task or purpose (example for a class assignment)
